The Key Skills were developed in response to our self-evaluation through consultation with children, staff, parents and partners and using national guidance.

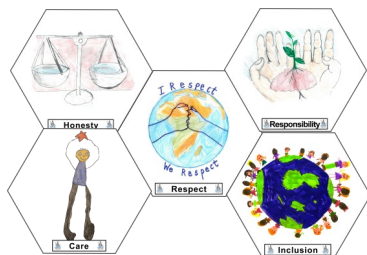
Our Curriculum at St. Ronan's
